Continued meeting from April 5, 2018

The continued meeting from April 5, 2018 of the Cuyuna City Council was held at 6:00 pm in City Hall. Present were Mayor Brix and council members Eisen and Zontelli. Absence were council members Z.Brix and Stockard. Mayor Brix led the Pledge of Allegiance.

Mayor explained the purpose of the meeting was to answer questions on the recent letter sent to property owners with non-compliant private sanitary lines requiring repair/replacement and also the removal of individual sump pumps directing property water into the city system.

City Engineer Tim Houle and Tony Pohl presented the agenda and provided back ground history of the recent city sanitary sewer project completed with significant grants. One of the requirements of the grant funding agencies was all private sanitary lines feeding into the city main line be televised and if directing storm water/ground infiltration flows, they must be corrected. This is also a city ordinance requirement. There were 8 property owners in attendance.

Jim Radinovich, property owner of 700' of private line, said he had fixed some of the cleanouts and how would he know if this fixed his issue. Tim Houle noted he and the property owner could meet separately to discuss possible options.

Mike Workman, property owner, understood he needs to hook a new line up to North Street, but wished he had received more notice regarding the requirement to fix it so he could have save up money. Tim Houle explained that there were several public hearings on this project and scope and there were previous notices sent to the property owners.

Tim Houle shared with the audience it would be beneficial for the property owners to decide on a contractor and contact the city clerk who will help communicate coordinating a time the contractor and Tim Houle/Tony Pohl could look at the video of the televised line to help get an accurate quote.

Clerk received a request for dog/cat applications and will mail to the resident.

Council heard from Nick Underwood a request to build a shed on his property line. Councilmember Zontelli noted the set back is 10' and would not be in favor of a variance. Councilmember Eisen asked if the property line surveyor stakes could be found. Mr. Underwood did not know.

Mayor shared a request from a property owner on North Street regarding vacating an unused street. Clerk will provide information to the council and Mayor for that area.

**Motion by Zontelli to adjourn. Second by Eisen. Motion carried unanimously.**
